

Dartskins Poker: Official Rules

Players: 2-6 players

Equipment:

 Dartskins Poker game and pins for set up (first, un-clip the number ring of the dartboard and pin to the dartboard).

- Darts
- Scorecard As shown:

Gameplay:

- **Hand Building:** Dartskins Poker follows standard open-hand poker rules. Players build their 5-card hand by hitting designated card sections on the board.
- Throws per Round: Each player/team will use 6 dart throws to set their hand.
 - Flop (First 3 Cards): Each player/team throws 3 darts, recording the cards hit as their "flop."
 - Turn & River Cards (Next 2 Cards): After everyone records their flop, all players throw 2 more darts each to build their 5-card hand (turn and river cards).
 - Sixth Dart (Optional): If missing cards or hitting duplicate cards, players can use their final dart to complete their hand. (note - opposing players can have duplicate cards in their hand)
- **Penalties for Incomplete Hands:** Players who cannot build a 5-card hand with their 6 dart throws start the next round with fewer cards based on missed throws.
- **Discard and Build:** After the setting the initial hand, players can discard up to 3 cards they don't want. Players then take turns throwing darts equal to the number of cards they discarded to improve their hand.

Dart Placement:

- On the Line is In: A dart touching the line between card sections counts as hitting that card.
- **Winning: Winning Hand:** The player/team with the best poker hand at the end of the rounds win the pot.
